General goal	The refresher course is addressed to the teachers who already work in the field of integration or who will start this experience, in order to offer the theoretical knowledge and the operative instruments to support their activities in the class.
Specific goal	Providing the participants with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a theoretical frame of reference - instruments for the evaluation of learning problems in the training programme - some intervention methodologies.
Expected outcomes	Training of local teachers who work in the following fields: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - autism, with particular reference to the development problems - reading problems - the delay in the acquisition of oral language - the strategies of cognitive enrichment in the didactic practice
