Aim	The present research aims to answer the following questions: 1) Is there a change in the way participants to Rondine experience perceive the enemy and the outgroup? 2) Is there a change in the way participants perceive themselves and their ingroup?
Methods	The research began in January 2017, achieved its first results in June 2018 and was divided into three waves: beginning of the academic year (T1, October 2017), half of the academic year (T2, February 2018) and end of the academic year (T3, May 2018). For data collection, it was decided to adopt a multimethodological approach. Specifically, the students of the World House and the fourth year of excellence were asked to fill in three different tools: focus group, heraldic shield (graphic instrument) and self-report questionnaire.
Results/Operational Implications	From the comparative analysis of the first four waves, it emerges that, in both groups, there is a process of awareness that underlines a movement, an evolution and a change of the definition of conflict and the perception of the enemy. Data collection of fifth wave is in progress.
